This past July, Alpha Mu kicked its recolonization efforts into high gear, with the announcement of our ongoing “409 Club.” I won’t be shy here, it’s a mountain to climb – we need 125K just to get to a state of our bills being paid and necessary cleanup for the new group of young men about to inhabit our home for the first time in four years.

I continue to be encouraged by the outpouring of Alumni support. In a little over a month, 52 Brothers have stepped up to make a gift of \$409 or more to this club and raised over \$30,000. Additionally, 101 Brothers have continued to keep our annual fund going, which allows for communications such as monthly eLetters, and Alpha Musings – our print newsletter, and these financial asks that sustain the lifeblood of our beloved Fraternity.

But we need more help. As Alumnus **Harry Barfoot ’77** explained, “If everyone contributes something we’re on our way to meeting our mutual goal of re-opening 409 East Fairmount Avenue!”

I thank each and every one of you who has stepped up to make your gift over the years, and to those who have given to our annual fund and now, the 409 Club. Both annual Fund Donors and 409 Club donors are recognized on the reverse side of this letter.
